

## HUFF N' PUFF RUN - TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. Huff & Puff is a timed running event. Competitive runners are encouraged to enter; however, social runners are also welcome. A separate Family Fun Run will be held concurrently.
2. Race timing is as follows:

TIME	ACTIVITY
8.00am	Train Departs Thirlmere Station
8.10am	Arrives Courijah Station, front 2 carriages disembark for Fun Run
8.15am	Steam Train departs Couridjah 8.15am to Buxton for main race
8.30am	Arrives Buxton at 8.30am – remaining carriages disembark
8.50am	Main Race Commences 8.50am from Buxton – Fun Run commences Couridjah concurrently
9.20am	Train arrives Thirlmere
9.45am	Main race concludes (All Professional Runners)
12.00pm	Fun Run Concludes - Road Closures progressively open

3. Children 12 and under must be accompanied by an adult for the entire duration of the event and the accompanying adult takes full responsibility for the safety of the entrant 12 years or under. Participants over the age of 12 can complete the event without an adult accompanying them.
4. A separate online entry form is required for each entrant
5. All entry fees must be paid at time of registration. Once entry closes, late entries and on the day entries will not be available.
6. Entry fees are as follows:

7. Entry fees are not refundable - unless the event is cancelled by Wollondilly Shire Council
8. Entries close on Thursday 22nd May 2024 – unless sold out prior & Run only closes 17th May
9. Timing bibs will be utilised for this event and will be available for pick up at registration on the morning of the event. (Run only ticket holders will collect from Registration table at Buxton Train Station but no on the day registrations).
10. Please ensure your timing bib is securely pinned to the front of t-shirt/singlet, as this records your time
11. Runners are welcome to push a stroller/pram and they must start from the designated Stroller Start Area, which is located behind the start line, to ensure a safe, injury free start for all. Note, the course is on the road so a suitable stroller/pram is required.
12. Prizes will be awarded across the following categories:

1st Place Male - \$250.00	1st Place Junior Male - \$100.00
1st Place Female - \$250.00	1st Place Junior Female - \$100.00
2nd Place Male - \$150.00	<i>*Family Fun Run not eligible for prize money*</i>
2nd Place Female - \$150.00	

13. The race will commence from Buxton at 10am. All entrants must have completed the race by 11.30am. The roads will open by midday. Runners not finished by 11.30am will be asked to leave the run course and you will be listed as 'Did Not Finish' and no time will be recorded.
14. There's no child minding available on the day – spectators under adult supervision are welcome to register as a spectator and pay to be a spectator on the train (unless sold out prior). Alternatively, spectators are welcome to gather at the finish line.
15. Pets, rollerblades, skates, scooters, skateboards and bikes are not allowed.
16. First aid stations are located at the Start/Finish area and first aiders will be monitoring the course on push bikes throughout the race
17. Water stations: One water station will be available at the start-line, on the course at approximately the halfway point, and there will also be a water station available at the finish line. Food and drinks will be available for purchase at the end of the event from local businesses.
18. A toilet will be available at the start and finish lines. Toilets will not be available on the course
19. Stay on the defined course as any departure may lead to disqualification.
20. All decisions by the Race Director are final.
21. All entrants who complete their event will be eligible to download an online finisher's certificate that will be made available in the week after the event.
22. Lost property will be taken to the event registration area at the NSW Rail Museum.
